





3. If date format not in date format: dd/MM/yyyy (28/11/2017), then need to change the date format.
4. GOTO Window start button > search: Control Panel > View By: Category > Change date, time, or number formats > Additional Setting > Date Tab > Short format: dd/MM/yyyy > Apply > OK

Short date: 28/11/2017

Long date: Tuesday, November 28, 2017

Date formats

Short date: dd/MM/yyyy

Long date: dddd, MMMM d, yyyy

What the notations mean:
d, dd = day; ddd, dddd = day of week; M = month; y = year

Calendar

When a two-digit year is entered, interpret it as a year between:


1930 and 2029

First day of week: Sunday
