

Price Group, Price Book, Last Selling Price Setting in QNE Optimum

1. Please go to the menu bar and select Sales>Selling Price Priority



2. From here, you can change the priority sequence by clicking the buttons "Move Up" and "Move Down" .You can also click the checkbox to either enable or disable whether the selling price should refer to the particular price type.



3. Click the button "Price History" and you can see a screen which recorded the last selling price from different transaction types.
