



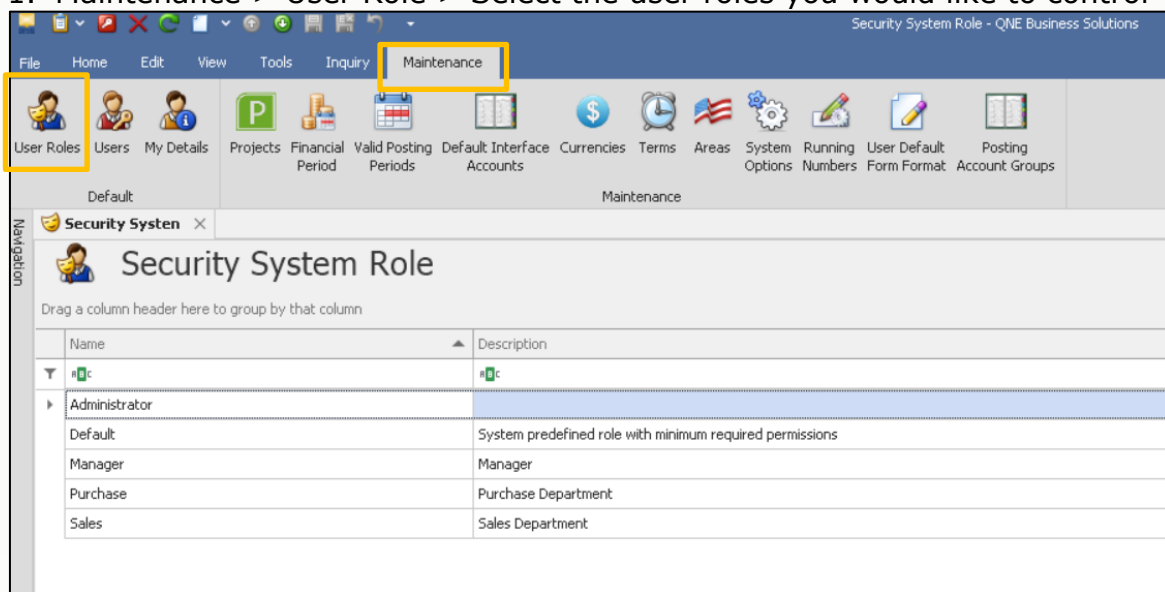
How to set Web or Windows based User Access Right

Scenario:

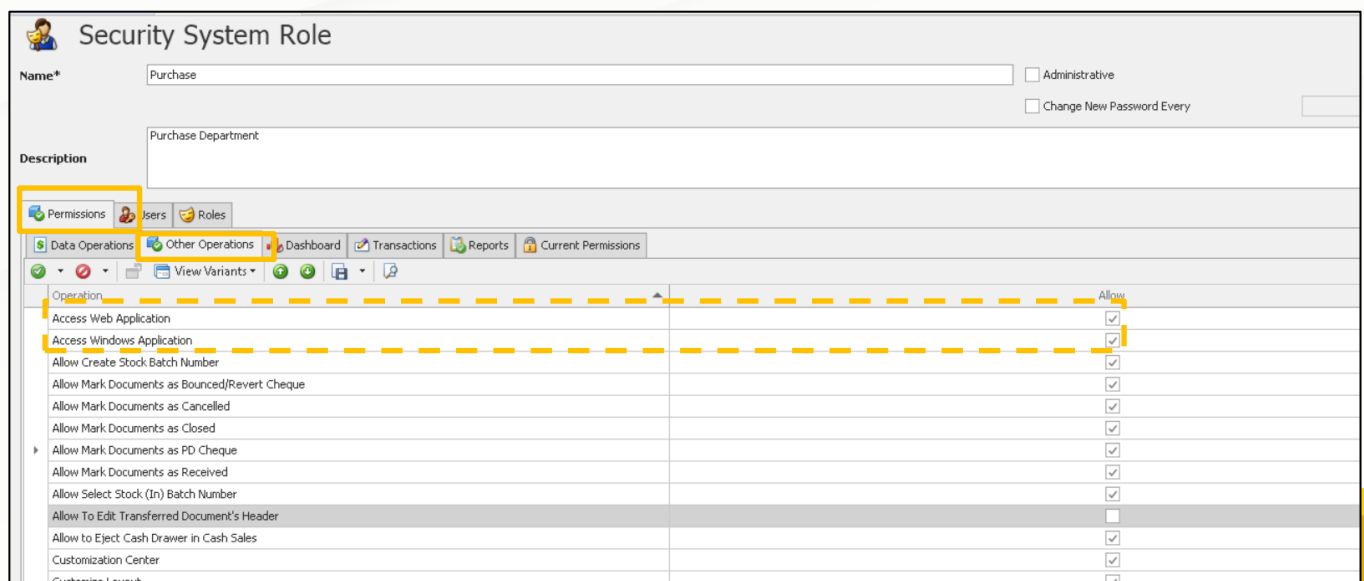
This setting determines whether users have permission to access and log in to the Windows-based application. By adjusting this setting, administrators can control who can use the application and who cannot

Solution

1. Maintenance > User Role > Select the user roles you would like to control




2. Permission > Other Operations

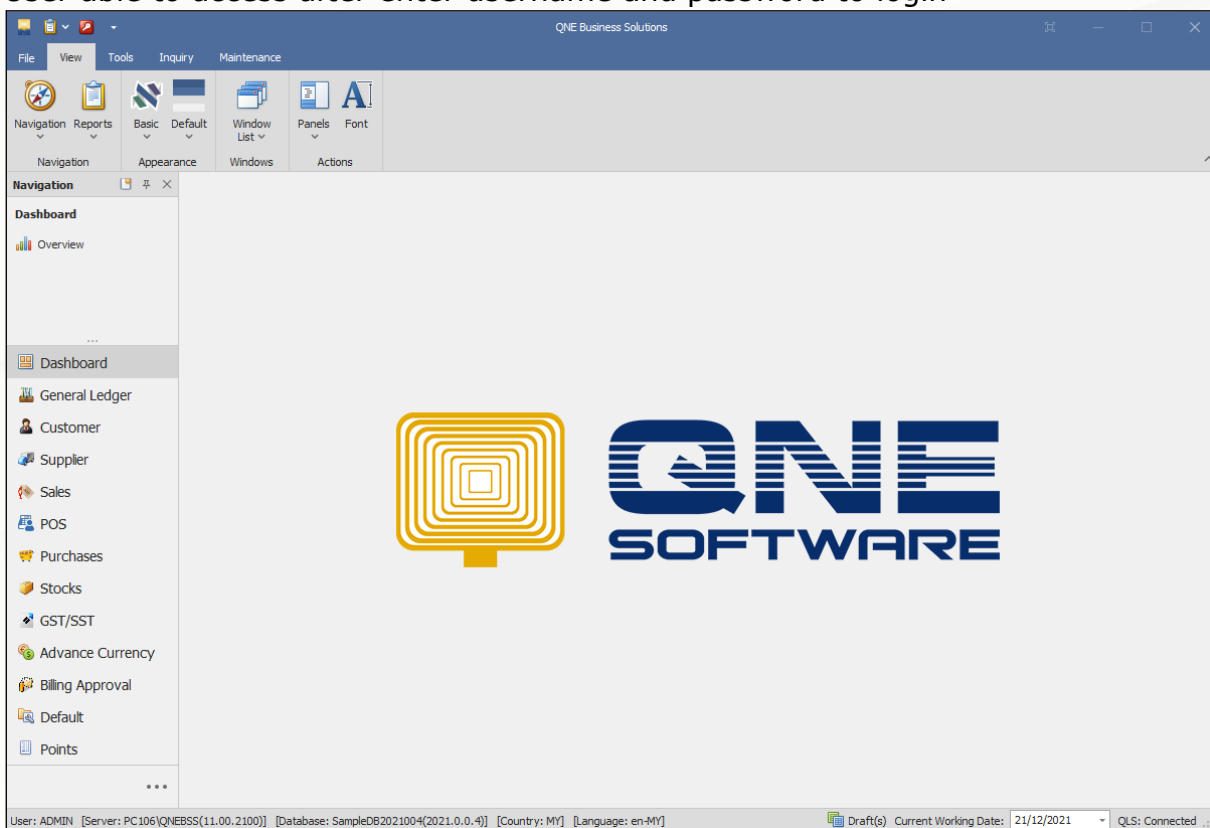
4. Allow **Access Windows Application setting** is ticked to allow user using QNE in windows.
